# The Shadows ALL DAY VERSION B

Mono (?) – Take unknown. This is an alternative arrangement using a tambourine continuo instead of drums. It also exhibits a prominently different bass pattern and ends with a fade-out.

On vinyl, this "ultra-rare" version was only to be found on the ostensibly stereo (8 tracks were in mono!) December 1966 Japanese LP *Thunderbirds Are Go!* (See *The Shadows At EMI* p. 430). It is certain that the wrong master tape had been sent to Japan, but the truth was not discovered prior to the release.

Always a rarity, copies of this track were included twice on the controversial Italian 'Fremus' CD issues from 1994 [legal under Italian law at the time]. The Left-sided sound balance on the *Dakota* release hints at instrument separation and this recording was abstracted directly from the original "stereo" LP. The later *Atlantis* release contains a distinctly mono rendition (albeit the balance is Left of centre) from an unrecognised source.

The Japanese album track was "legitimised" on the December 1999 French Digipak release *Out Of The Shadows* but VERSION B has never been formally released in the UK and British collectors still have to import copies.

# Marvin, Welch & Farrar ALL DAY, ALL NIGHT BLUES MIX 2

The Quadraphonic mixing: during the slide-guitar fills, competing hi-hat cymbals can be heard rather prominently. Second Opinion was the only MW & F Album to be produced (albeit in limited quantities) using the Quadraphonic format and few people today have equipment capable of exploiting its potential. The record can be played via normal stereo systems but the sound is not as originally intended.

The Quadraphonic album was released later than the standard LP. It was issued in June 1972 and the copyright date printed on the gatefold inner artwork reflects this fact.

Because of the very nature of Quadraphonic Sound the overall mixings will be dissimilar to those found on the equivalent stereo recordings. Only the most prominent variations have been reported here but all tracks on the LP display minor listening differences.

The remixing first appeared as a "taster" on the January 1977 picture cover "maxi" Single EMI 2573 just before the 20 Golden Greats LP was released. The Single contained three remixed tracks from the album: APACHE (above) as the A-side together with new [Type 2] mock-stereo versions of WONDERFUL LAND and FBI on side-B. For some reason, the 1977 stereo remixing of APACHE has escaped the attention of compilers.

It is interesting to note that a prior manifestation of this "maxi" Single, the November 1972 release DB 8958,

contained three entirely different mixings of the same tracks, i.e. the original stereo version of APACHE (MIX 1) and two earlier [Type 1] mock-stereo versions of FBI and WONDERFUL LAND made especially for the so-called stereo release of the *Greatest Hits* LP in 1971.

# The Shadows THE BOYS MIX 3: Mock-stereo

The 1962 mono master tape was electronically reprocessed to give a limited stereo effect.

Included on the August 1971 so-called "stereo" reissue of the *Greatest Hits* UK compilation LP, this track was joined by FBI and WONDERFUL LAND when all three were presented in mock-stereo.

For unfathomable reasons (a good, true stereo master was patently available) the mono master tape for this track was subjected to careful electronic reprocessing to produce what appears to be a quite unnecessary mock-stereo version. For this, the cymbals were spread towards the edges of the sound image and they can be heard clearly, being balanced equally about the centre.

The only other vinyl release for this mockstereo version was on the February 1985 Australian LP *The Shadows Favourites* – it was not surprising then, that the first CD release of the track was on the (eventual) CD issue of this compilation album in September 1988.

When the track was included on the February 1989 Dutch 2CD *The Definitive Guitar Album*, it was quite incorrectly designated 'Theme From The Boys' on both the case and the liner notes.

Here, uniquely, there is some evidence of manipulation to separate the mono sounds. In particular, the bass is heard distinct from other instruments.

First evident on CD on the 1991 release *Best Now*, this track with an unusual Right-sided balance is confined to Japan but the recording has appeared a number of times over recent years. Significantly, it has never been marked 'Mono' as would be expected.

The studio re-recording of DRIFTIN' with a heavy Right-sided balance first appeared

on the 1969 Japanese 2LP All About The Shadows, although the technique of balancing mono tracks to the far Right or Left to give an 'impression' of stereo had been common practice in Japan for years. The LP and the later CD track probably come from the same source, however they are not identical. The CD version is much brighter and gives an even stronger impression of sound separation: this may well have been achieved in modern digital
