The attention-grabbing short, (recorded a month after the track itself and then spliced on) has a vast amount of echo incorporated into Hank's first, loud, "Hello, This is an important announcement - I suppose!" Generally, when played through the cinema's PA system it would have stopped the audience in its collective tracks! The tune itself however, is a plain mono recording.

While a few lucky collectors managed to acquire the British cinema Single, the first "commercial" release of this track came in 1969 when (inexplicably) it was included on the Dutch LP The Best Of The Shadows. The item has not appeared elsewhere.

MIDNIGHT is a case in point – the echo and reverberation applied interferes with and distorts the integrity of the snare drum and Bruce is quoted as "disliking" his electric guitar sound. The mono mix masks the technical problems to a degree and this perhaps explains why it was included on the excellent 1990 LP/CD release *The Original Chart Hits 1960-80* in preference to the stereo track.

In a typically British mixing, the instruments are spread to the opposite edges of the stereo sound image. Lead guitar is heard on the far Right with all the other instruments being located far Left. This leaves the centre space virtually empty except for two short, overdubbed "vocal" interludes.

"The voices must have been dubbed because Bruce's acoustic guitar would have been recorded on an open mike, and this would have picked up his voice and placed it with the guitar – on the Left ..... anyway, the voices sound dubbed, and what's more, they are acoustically different to the rest of the track.": Jim Nugent, Article 'Norrie Paramor's Production Techniques', *SCOFA* (1991) p. 15.

This shifting of the lead guitar towards the centre was found first on the 1967 French LP *The Shadows 60's* (see *The Shadows At EMI* p. 426); however the other instruments remained near the LH edge. On this rare item (it is said only 5000 were made) an apparent date [30867] was etched on the disc itself and it was almost certainly abstracted directly from a copy of the mono master used for the Jugoton EP/UK Single [see VERSION B].

This 6", 33rpm flexidisc probably just predated the official "commemorative" EPs when it was included in a printed brown paper cover with the Yugoslavian teen magazine *džuboks* (Jukebox) No.9 to celebrate The Shadows' participation (and win) at the 1967 Split Song Festival [between 4-6 August]. Two Yugoslavian "commemorative" mono EPs were issued on the Jugoton label in the Autumn of 1967 (Pistolesi's book *That Sound!* p.113 indicates orchestral overdubs were added to I CAN'T FORGET on 26-8-67 and, if so, the EP releases would not predate this). Very similar in style, they were both

entitled *Melodije Jadrana* and bore the same photo looking across the concert hall from behind the orchestra. Each of the EPs contained a song from The Shadows' performance – the first, EPY 3962, included RUNNING OUT OF WORLD while the second, EPY 3963, had the Festival's winning song I CAN'T FORGET (see *The Shadows At EMI* p. 282). The remaining six tracks were by other Song Festival contestants.
